He excels at resolving complex design challenges such as at the Philadelphia Museum of Art where the program required reworking the main electrical distribution system while keeping the building open and running throughout construction. Joe is a highly skilled project manager and has also designed IT and AV systems, notably for the 450,000 sf renovation and expansion of Staples High School in Westport, CT.
